I recently learned my child’s school is using “critical race theory” or “1619 Project” materials to teach the students. As a person of color, I strongly object to the messages these materials send. The reason is crystal clear. I agree with Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., when he declared: “I have a dream that one day down in Alabama, with its vicious racists with its governor having his lips dripping with the words of ‘interposition’ and ‘nullification’ one day right there in Alabama little black boys and black girls will be able to join hands with little white boys and white girls as sisters and brothers.” His message was racial harmony.
